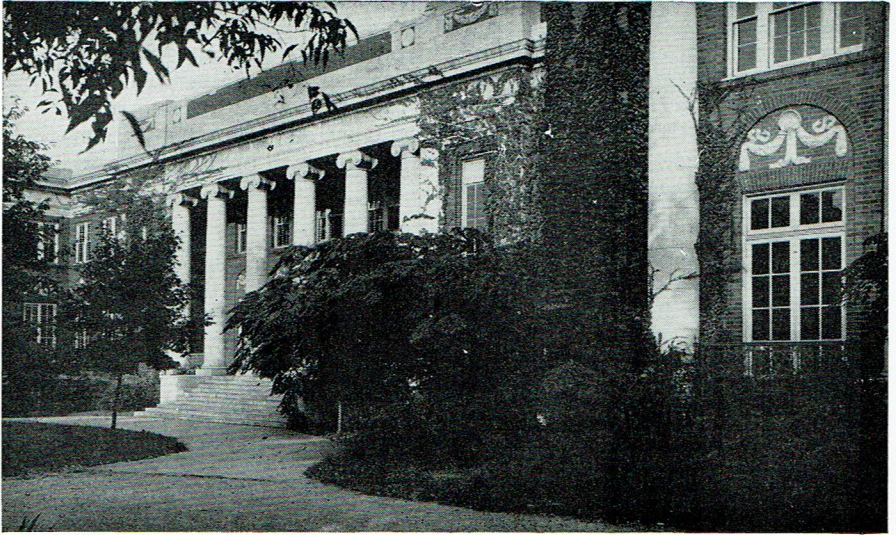


# A SCIENCE CURRICULUM
